
Skypark.

How to get here





The Exhibition rail station is located directly across from Skypark, with connections every 10 minutes to Glasgow Central and Queen Street stations. Anderston and Charing Cross stations are approximately 10 minutes walk away.



Glasgow City Centre and the main train stations are a twenty minute walk from Skypark, following St Vincent Street east. The New Media Quarter is a ten minute walk. Local amenities include sandwich & coffee shops, bars, restaurants, gyms and boutiques.



Skypark encourages cycling to work and plentiful cycle racks are provided across the site. A new indoor cycle store includes 250 bike racks, lockers, showers, changing area and drying room. Riverside cycle paths lead to the City Centre, the Exhibition Centre, the West End, and the BBC/New Media Quarter.



First Bus number 2 runs from the City Centre and the West End, with departures every 7 minutes from St Vincent Street. This service route operates from Faifley, Clydebank, Partick, City Centre, Parkhead, Shettleston, Baillieston or Airdrie. Stagecoach X19 service runs every 10 minutes between the South QEUH, Govan, City Centre, to the East, with a stop at Anderston Quay.



Skypark is accessible from the M8 motorway, the Clydeside Expressway and St Vincent Street. (Sat Nav Post Code is G3 8EP). We offer free on-site parking for visitors.



Glasgow airport is approximately 20 minutes from Skypark by taxi. There is also a shuttle service running from the airport to the City Centre, taking approximately 25 minutes.
